Hello Lynda,

We are currently working on a return to skate policy/procedure but until it's available, we strongly recommend receiving medical clearance prior to allowing the child/skater on the ice after a significant injury.

We suggest reinforcing the safety precautions (ex. helmet use), along with the normal supervision by the coach or program assistants.

It is also very important to ensure the parents/guardians and skater are fully aware of the risk.
