If you send an update, label it Jane Doe, Star 6 Women FS update1 (in case there is more than 1 update). All planned program sheets are to be in by the registration deadline. Updates should be in by the update deadline which is usually the weekend before the competition to allow time to download and merge the forms for the judging sheets.

Our first competition is Vancouver Island Interclub in Parksville, November 18-20, 2016 hosted by Fuller Lake SC. Karen will be Chief Data Specialist and I will be Computer Data Specialist. Our data specialists will be hard at work getting results out in their usual timely manner starting Thursday to get the paperwork ready for the judges.

Our second competition is Vancouver Island Region Championships which will be held in Nanaimo by Nanaimo SC on February 3 - 5, 2016.
